


Calling all 3rd, 4th and 5th graders, if you like science, please join us with your science projects!

Details and Reasons to Participate:

- **Student Driven**, individual project or together with a friend. The kids do it all and own it! All work (research, experiment, trifold creation) is completed at home and then students showcase their experimental findings for friends, family and fellow WES students while hosting a table on Science Fair Night. The student scientists will stamp fellow WES students' science passports as these students visit science fair tables. What great leadership!
- **Noncompetitive**. *Pure fun!* No individual awards but questions, feedback, and many compliments will be given.
- **Be Creative or Choose an Experiment from a Website or Book**. Consider the links below for science project ideas. Science experiment books are also on display and for checkout at the WES library. You will likely have the most fun doing an experiment on a topic that interests you!

- Lab Safety. Remember, <u>always</u> conduct experiments under parental supervision and with proper lab safety equipment. You may need goggles and aprons for safety. Research and consider safety before conducting experiments.
- Trifold Creation and Table Display. Each project will have a table at the science fair. Below is an example of a set-up for a trifold display. A trifold display is not required (along with other stores, we have seen trifolds at Dollar Tree). Students may be as creative as they wish and may bring in materials from their experiment, books or resources used, hands-on activities or food samples as they relate. Students may also do demonstrations. Please let us know in advance if you wish to do a demonstration so we know what to expect and assist with the best set-up.
